The proposed contest of the two artists was to take place at the house of Count Flemming, Marchand's special protector. The King having fixed the day and hour, and Volumier having notified it to Bach, the latter sent the usual challenge to Marchand, couched in the most polite terms, in which he asked his fellow artist to favor him with any musical themes he may select, to be executed extempore, provided that his opponent would do the same. Marchand accepted, and pledged himself to appear at the appointed hour.





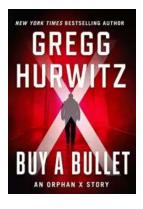

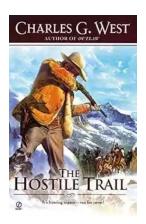
