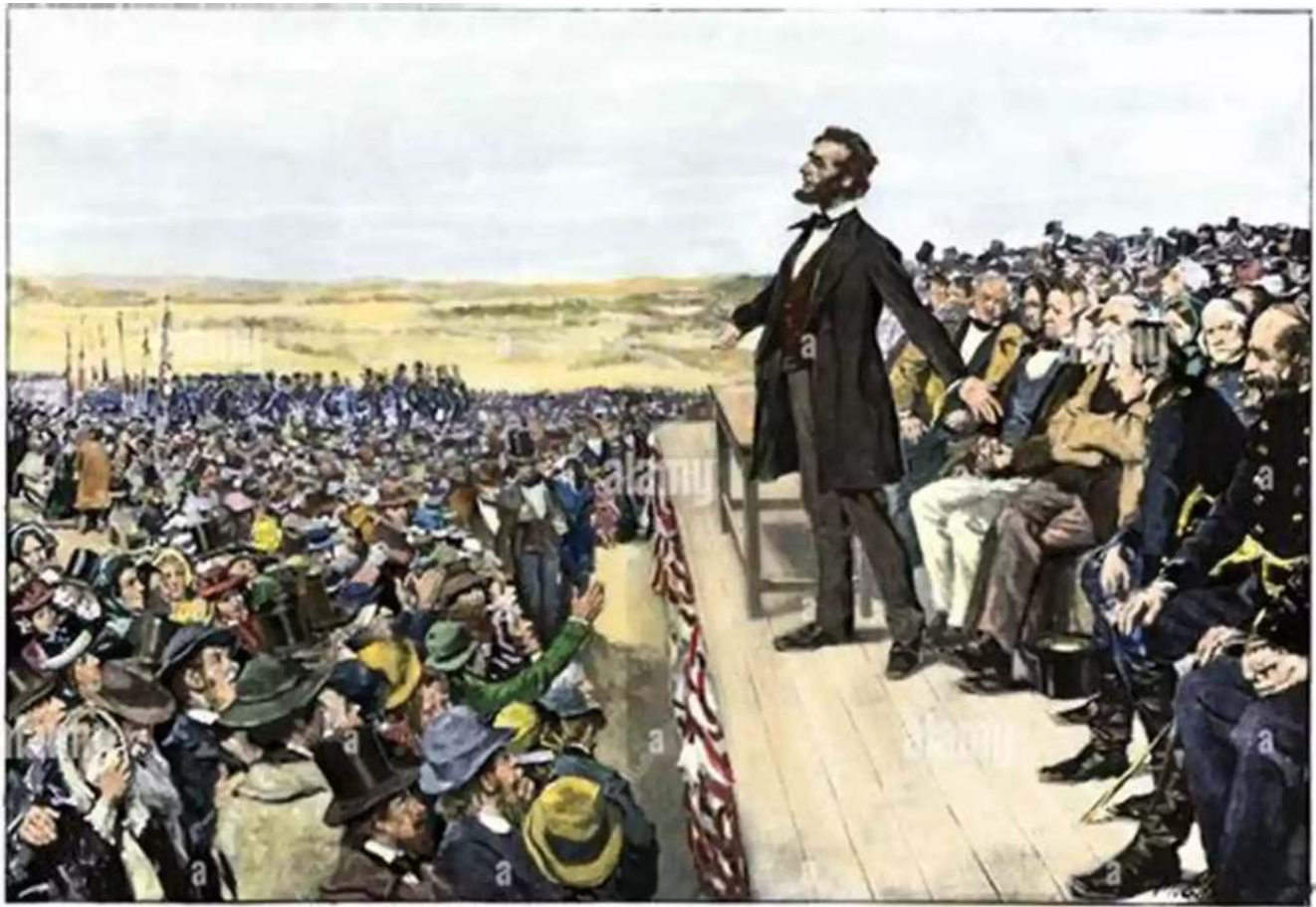


Gettysburg Address: The Timeless Words of Abraham Lincoln

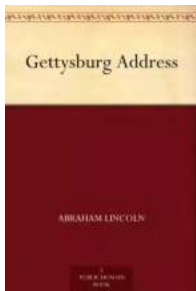


LINCOLN'S ADDRESS AT GETTYSBURG, NOVEMBER 19, 1863

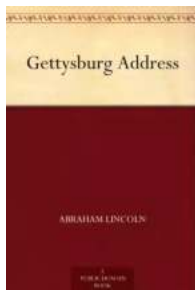

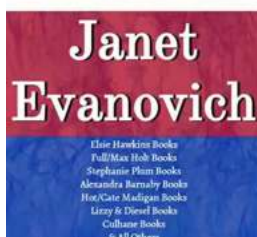
